

HOCKEY INDIA

ANNUAL GRANTS TO MEMBER UNITS FINANCIAL YEAR 2020-21

* Any Member Unit that does not participate in both the sub-junior men and women annual Hockey India National Championships 2020, they will only be entitled to be considered for 50% of the eligible grant provided they qualify for the grant.

1.0 PERMANENT MEMBERS

The grant for 2020-21 will be paid in 3 instalments, after submission of necessary documents and reports required by Hockey India as per the conditions of eligibility. The total amount of grant payable for 2021-21 will be Rs 10.00 Lakhs per annum

The first instalment of Rs 3.00 Lakhs will be given only to those states that have submitted all their respective documents for all the previous years prior to 25 March 2020 of the Accounting Year prior to each of the instalment details.

The second instalment of Rs 3.50 Lakhs will be given only after the information stated below in the conditions and pending documents related to previous years up to 2020-21 are provided (as per point 1.1.2).

The third instalment of Rs 3.50 Lakhs will be released after the information given in the conditions listed below (as per point 1.1.3).

1.1 CONDITIONS

1.1.1 FIRST INSTALMENT

The first instalment will be **given only** to those states that have submitted all their documents for and up to and including 2020-21, as per the Policy 'Hockey India Regulations for Grant to Member Units'.

1.1.2 SECOND INSTALMENT

(Last date by or before 31st December of the Accounting Year)

The information required to be sent / provided to fulfil the conditions of receiving the **second instalment** of the grant for State Members for the period 2020-21 includes;

- a. Provide the State Activities Report (as per template) for the conduct of your men and women State Championships for 2020 in the categories of Senior, Junior and Sub Junior as per Activities Template for the period of 1 January – 31 December 2020.

- b. Provide the details (as per presentation template) for the conduct of your men and women State Championships for 2020 in the categories of Senior, Junior and Sub Junior which need to be conducted between 1 January – 31 December 2020.
- c. Provide a copy of the current Constitution as on 31 December 2020. Details of any changes in the Constitution in 2020 to be provided.
- d. Provide a copy of your Registration of Association along with signed Affidavit that the Registration of Association is still valid as at 31 December 2020.
- e. It is mandatory for all players to be registered on the Hockey India Member Unit Portal by 31 December 2020. There will be expectations that your athlete numbers should increase a minimum of 5 percent each year.

1.1.3 THIRD INSTALLMENT

(By or before 25th March of the Current Accounting Year)

- o. Provide dates for conduct of your teams selection trials for the 2020 Hockey India National Championships and conduct of the selection trials as per Hockey India rules
- p. Confirmation that the dates for the Member Unit teams selection trials were disseminated as per Hockey India rules.
- q. Participate in a minimum 4 out of 6 Hockey India National Championships for 2020/21 (10th Hockey India National Championships).
- r. Letter from your State Government or State Sports Department or State Director of Sports or State Sports Council confirming that you are the only Hockey Unit in their State recognised by them to manage men and women hockey in your State and affiliated with the National Federation, Hockey India for the period up to 31 March 2020.

2.0 ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

The grant for Associate Member Units (not institutional members) will be Rs 4.50 Lakhs per annum for 20-21 towards conduct of their activities in their respective areas.

The grant for 20-21 will again be paid in 3 equal instalments, after submission of necessary documents and reports required by Hockey India as per the conditions of eligibility.

The first instalment of Rs 1.50 will be given to those Associate Members that have submitted all their documents up to and including 2020-21.

The second instalment of Rs 1.50 Lakhs will be given only after the information stated below in the conditions and any pending documents relating to the previous years and up to and including 2020-21 are provided (as per point 2.1.2).

The third instalment of Rs 1.50 Lakhs will be released after the information given in the conditions listed below (as per point 2.1.3).

3.0 ACADEMIES MEMBERS AND HOC-KEY MEMBERS

The grant for Academy Members and Hoc-Key Members that are not institutional members will be Rs 3.00 Lakhs per annum for 2020-21 towards conduct of their activities in their respective areas.

Last date to receive deliverables is by or before 31st December of the Accounting Year.
