Hockey India also invited former Australia great Fergus Kavanagh to work with the Men's and Women's teams. National Coaching Camps for the Senior Men's and Women's team were organised in the months of July and August.

The month of August saw Merzban Patel, Manuel Fredericks and Chinglensana Singh Kangujam get conferred by the Hon'ble President of India with National Awards. While Merzban Patel was given the Dronacharya Award for his work at the grassroots level, Manuel Fredericks was conferred the Dhyan Chand Award for lifetime achievement. Experienced Midfielder of the Senior Men's team Chinglensana Singh Kangujam was given the prestigious Arjuna Award 2019 for his contribution to the sport. Hockey India is delighted with their feat, and would like to congratulate them for the honors.

The month of August also saw Hockey India conduct National Coaching Camps for the Junior Men and Women core probables.

After a successful first phase of the Hockey India Coaching Education Pathway which was launched earlier this year in April 2019, Hockey India started the next phase of the Pathway in August in order to further develop more Coaches from the grassroots and enable them to meet the requirements and the ever-growing demands of International hockey.

One of his various contributions to the sport of hockey, in November 2018, Mr. Jaitley launched a coffee-table book titled, "Hockey: A Saga of Triumph, Pain and Dreams", in a zest to document the triumphs and tears of Indian hockey.

Mohd Mushtaque Ahmad, President, Hockey India, condoled Mr Jaitley's demise. "I am deeply saddened by the sad demise of Shri Arun Jaitley ji. He was not just a political icon, but an astute statesman and an avid sports lover. Mr Jaitley always supported Indian Hockey throughout his career, and will be remembered fondly. On behalf of Hockey India, our sincere prayers that his soul finds eternal peace, and our heartfelt condolences to his family," he said.

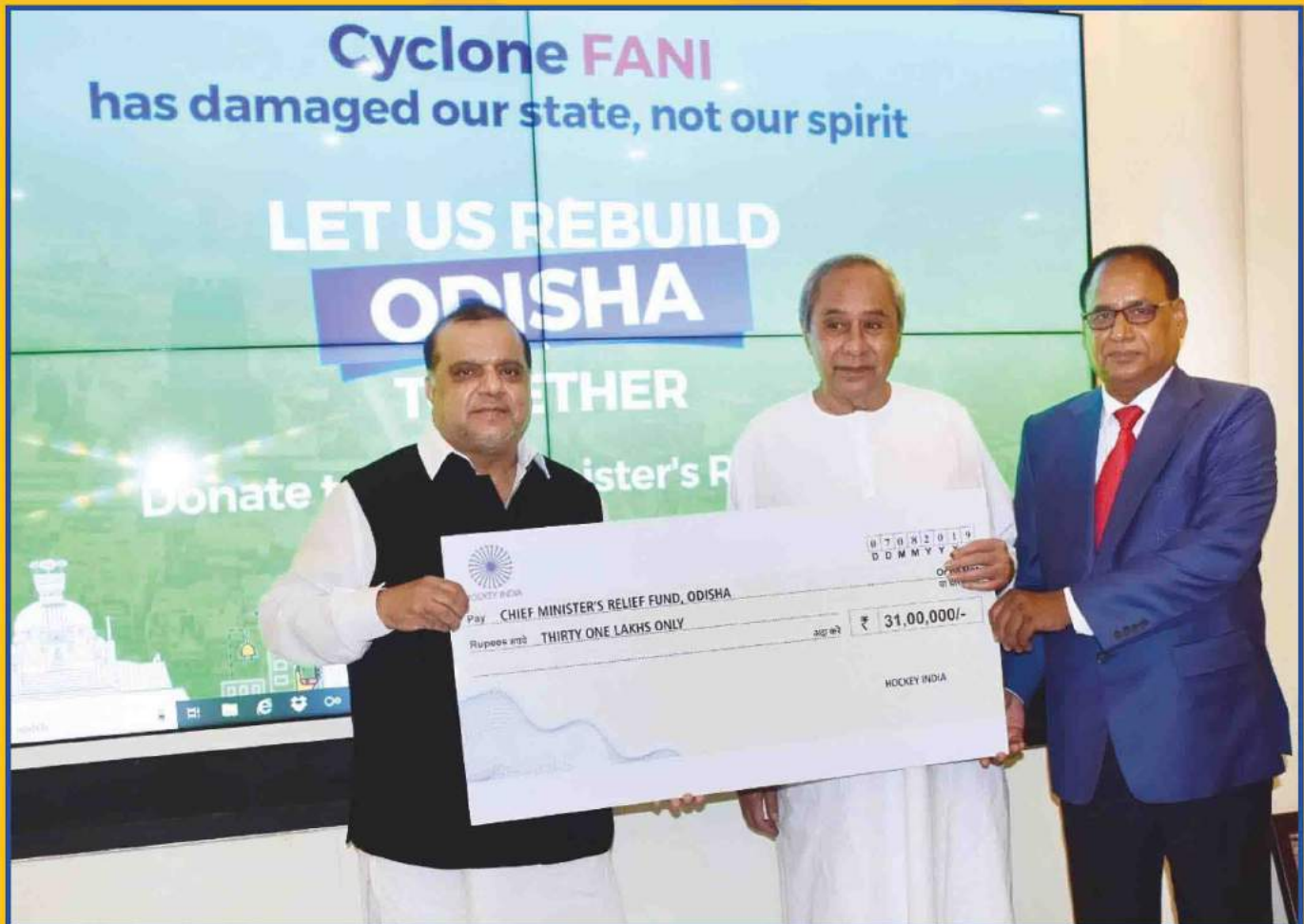

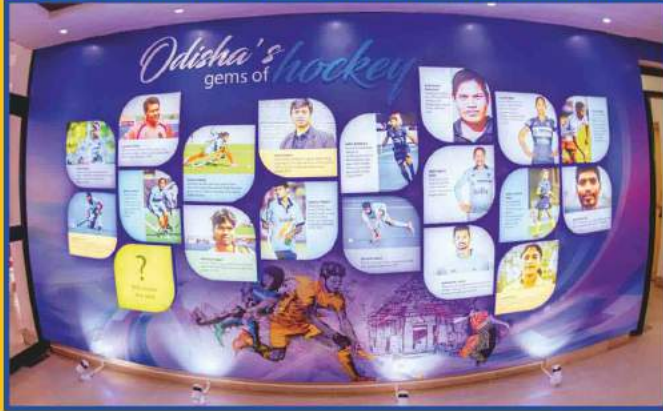

HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER SHRI NAVEEN PATNAIK INAUGURATED NAVAL TATA HOCKEY ACADEMY

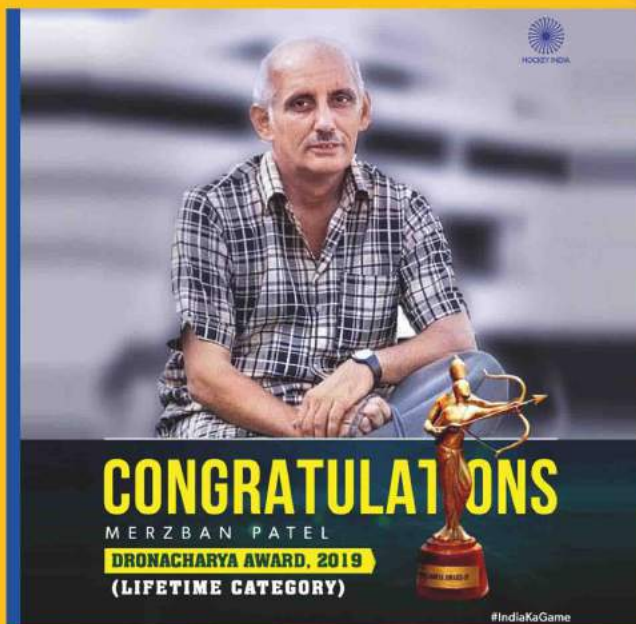
