ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION NO: Hockey/03/2021

Administrative approval of the Competent Authority is hereby accorded for holding of Jr. Men Coaching Camp from 07 - 19 November 2021 for 32 campers i.e. 24 players + 08 support staff at Bhubaneswar, Odisha. Players & Support Staff will report in the camp on 07 November 2021.

The Camps will be held at **Bhubaneswar**, **Odisha** for the preparation of Junior World Cup from 24th Nov to July to 05th Dec 2021 as per following camp norms:

- 1. Boarding @ Rs.480/- per head per day for all the campers.
- 2. Food Supplements @ Rs.320/- per head per day only. (for the Players only)
- 3. Lodging @ Rs. 1500/- per head per day.
- 4. F.O.P. Charges @ Rs.5000/- per day for camp on account of FOP Charges if requested by the Regional Director, SAI Regional Centre, Bengaluru, and the same will be paid as per actual.
- 5. The foreign coaches and Experts included in the said camp may be allowed lodging and local TA / Car for commutation on regular basis as per the training schedule/ official work, as per their entitlement spelt in their contract. (Single Room accommodation)
- 6. Interstate travel by Air if the journey is more than 1200 Km and less than 1200.Km is in 3rd A/C by train by shortest route from the resident state to the camp venue state, including local travel from residence to the nearest Rly. Stations/ Airport for both the ways.
- 7. Medical/Physiotherapy consumable as per actual subject to camp norms and all related bills and vouchers are to be settled at SAI, NSEC, Kolkata.
- 8. Sports Kit once in a year as per norms.
- 9. List of campers is enclosed.(Annexure A)

- 10. The expenditure to be incurred on the above camp may be debited to coaching camp head.
- 11. 8 bottles x 20 ltr. Water per training session
- 12. 15kg ice per training session
- 13. 70 kg crude ice during morning sessions all days
- 14. All age category camps (Youth, juniors and Sub-Jrs.) will commence only after age of players are verified as per the Age Certification test approved by MYAS. Players, who fall within the age range, be permitted to attend the camp to be organised by HI. However, since, the HI has selected all the probable's for the camp hence, will be held responsible for any discrepancy in the age of the campers. In case of doubt, he or she may be directed to go for age verification test from the hospitals which have been notified by SAI, head quarter, in consultation with RD, SAI, NSEC, Kolkata.
- 15. The expenditure to be incurred on the above camp may be debited to coaching camp head.
- 16. On conclusion of the Coaching Camp, National Coach/Coach In-charge shall submit a comprehensive report on Coaching Camp including performance of assistant coaches, supporting personal through Regional Head within 15 days to the CEO(TOPS).
- 17. Regional Head / Centre Head and the concerned Federation should submit monthly expenditure Statement on the last day of the month and utilisation certificate within 15 days of completion of the camp to the ED (F) with a copy to CEO(TOPS).
- 18. Approval for release of 75% advance for Rs. 6,12,360/- (Rupees Six Lakhs twelve thousand three hundred sixty only) to Hockey India by RD, **SAI**, **NSEC**, **Kolkata** for making necessary arrangement (Boarding, Lodging and food supplement) for holding the camp at Bhubaneswar.
