
Hon'ble Union Sports Minister Meets Hockey Junior World Cup Heroes

Hon'ble Minister of State (Independent Charge), Ministry of Youth Affairs And Sports, Mr. Vijay Goel met the junior men's Indian hockey team that recently won the Uttar Pradesh Hockey Junior World Cup Men Lucknow 2016 at his residence in Ashoka Road on 28 Dec 2016.

The team created history by winning the title after a gap of 15 years. The team had an unbeaten run in the tournament where they got the best of the likes of Australia in the Semi Finals, Spain in the Quarter Finals apart from beating Canada, South Africa and England in the pool stage.

Congratulating the team for their efforts, Goel announced a cash incentive of ₹3.70 lakhs per player. "Each one is a gem & I wish them all the very best for future," Goel said.









Rule Changes Approved by FIH Executive Board

The International Hockey Federation (FIH) Executive Board has agreed a number of changes to the forthcoming Hockey World Cups as well as adopting four quarters of 15 minutes for international hockey matches at all levels. These were the key decisions taken during FIH Executive Board meetings at the Hockey Revolution Part 2 Conference in Dubai in November.

The FIH Competitions Committee recommended changes to the Hockey World Cups, which the FIH Executive Board approved. With the 2018 Hockey World Cup moving to a 16 team event, changes to the format are as follows:

- 4 pools of 4 teams each
- Winners of each pool qualifies for Quarter Finals
- Last placed team in each Pool eliminated
- Crossovers between 2nd and 3rd in each of the Pools to determine the other four Quarter-Final teams
- Losers of crossovers eliminated
- Losers of Quarter Finals eliminated
- Semi-Finals and medal matches then take place
- Ranking of eliminated teams based on their performance at the time of elimination

Six Hockey Players Appointed as DSP in Punjab Police

The Punjab Government on Monday offered appointment letters to nine eminent international sports persons under the sports quota in a function organised in Chandigarh which was attended by deputy Chief Minister S Sukhbir Singh Badal.

Prolific midfielder Manpreet Singh, forward Akashdeep Singh, Sarvanjit Singh, Ramandeep Singh, Gurwinder Singh Chandi and Dharamvir Singh from the Indian men's hockey team that won the 2014 Asian Games Gold were appointed as Deputy Superintendent of Police. Manpreet Singh and Akashdeep Singh were also part of the team that won the historic Silver medal at the FIH Champions Trophy in London earlier this year apart from representing the country at the 2016 Rio Olympics and also winning the Asian Champions Trophy this year.
