ACTC 2021-2022 for Hockey

Minutes of ACTC meeting held on 26th November 2021: Hockey India (HI)

A meeting to finalize the Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC) for Hockey for the year 2021-22 was held on 26th November 2021 at 03.00 PM under the Chairmanship of Smt. Sujata Chaturvedi, Secretary (Sports) MYA&S at the Conference Hall, Sports Authority of India HQ, New Delhi.

The list of participants is annexed.

- At the outset, DG SAI welcomed all participants, and introduced the representatives
 of HI to the Secretary (Sports). He further appraised everyone present on the revision
 of norms for funding under the Assistance to NSF Scheme.
- 2. Hockey India provided the following assurances, as detailed below:
 - a) Formation of Team A- Structure, and plan for the same, considering adding a few members to their Senior National Camp, and creating an India Team A (Men and Women) to send for training and competition.
 - b) Foreign Coaches and Support Staff will conduct regular training sessions for Indian Coaches and Support staff, as decided (15 days annually, in online or offline mode).
- 3. A brief review of the previous ACTC (2019-21) was undertaken, and the following were brought to the notice of the Federation that should be complied with, at the earliest:
 - a) Scientific testing of all players participating in National Camps and International Training and Events at least 04 times in a year. Parameters for scientific testing would be worked out by HI and submitted to SAI.
 - b) Scientific data collected by all the coaches and support staff shall be shared on a quarterly basis with the TOPS team. Such data may be not used for any academic research, or shared with any external parties unless approved by the Sports Authority of India
 - Instead of national camps for Juniors year round, expert training to be provided in National Centres of Excellence (NCOEs).
 - d) Coaching camp would not be shifted from places approved in the Calendar, in case of shifting of camp places additional financial burden, that would be borne by HI.
- 4. The submitted ACTC for October 2021- March 2022 was discussed and the measurable outcomes as mutually agreed by Hockey India and Sports Authority of India (SAI) are annexed as Annexure 'A'.
- 5. The calendar and budget were considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The total budget for the annual calendar for training and competition was approved for HI up to March, 2022 with a cap of Rs. 12.54 Crores (Rupees Twelve Crores Fifty Four Lakhs Only) for the following:
 - a. National Coaching Camp (Senior)

- 6. It was noted that since the proposed Annual Calendar for Training & Competition was approved with a change in the overall budget, a review would be undertaken in the first week of February, for any additional requirement of funds subject to availability of budget under the 'Assistance to NSF' Scheme and subject to the following conditions:
 - a) Selection, justification and prioritization of the Equipment to be procured for the Sr Men and Women team, based on availability of stock in SAI Bengaluru.
 - b) Appropriate rationale for Rehabilitation camps, whenever proposed, of Sr Men and Women athletes to be conducted, outside the available facilities in SAI Bengaluru as to why the same cannot be conducted within the facilities available at SAI Bengaluru.
 - c) Plan for development of Junior athletes across India (Men and Women), over and above the two junior teams training at SAI Bengaluru. For example- The U-21 Khelo India League recently conducted successfully in MDCNS, Delhi
- 7. Modification can be made by NSF and duly approved by DG SAI as per actual proposal within the overall approved budget.
- 8. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
