

HOCKEY INDIA LOGO GUIDELINES

ABOUT HOCKEY INDIA

HOCKEY INDIA (HI) is the apex body with sole mandate to direct and conduct all activities for both Men and Women's Hockey in India. It is recognized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. of India as the sole body responsible towards promoting Hockey in India.

Headquartered in New Delhi, Hockey India was established on 20th May 2009 and is affiliated to the International Hockey Federation (FIH), the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) and Asian Hockey Federation (AHF).

With the assistance of Sports Authority of India and Department of Sports, Government of India, Hockey India has drawn out a Long-Term Development Programme (LTDP) to train players and to provide overseas exposure besides regular international competition.



THE LOGO

The design is intended to represent the speed, agility, and power of hockey players, and the colors were chosen to evoke a sense of strength and determination.

The logo is made up of 2 separate elements:

The Chakra:

Inspired by the Ashoka Chakra of the National flag, its made of 24 hockey sticks with 15 degree space between head of each sticks

The Logotype:

The name (HOCKEY INDIA) is specially configured typeface placed in 3 quarters of the distance as between the head of 2 hockey sticks in the chakra.



LOGO CLEAR SPACES /SAFE ZONE

When using the logo, always allow a protective space around it.

Minimum clear distance around the logo is equivalent to the 1*HOCKEY on the horizontal sides & 2*HOCKEY on the vertical sides and the distance from chakra and logotype is above the start of the horizontal line of H in HOCKEY.

This minimum clear distance should always be respected as it gives clarity and strength to the Logo.

COLOUR VARIATIONS

The logo may be reproduced in three colour options - full colour, black, and white. We have developed the two latter options for negative and positive use of the logo.

LOGO MISUSE

When reproducing the logo, we must always take care and protect its original form. To ensure the strength of the logo, consistency is of utmost importance. Please do not redraw or alter the icon, the logotype, proportions, size, colour or relationship of the elements.



Do not stretch the logo




Do not apply gradient to the logo



Do not rotate/change the logo angle



Do not change the placement of chakra or logotype



Do not crop the logo



Do not resolve the logo in two different colours

LOGO LOCKUPS - HORIZONTAL


Logo lock up - When the HI logo is associated with any other company or brand, certain usage guidelines should be taken into consideration.


The examples on the left show the correct way that the HI logo should be associated with any 'other' brand.

In certain instances, an accompanying strapline is a sufficient way of demonstrating any third-party associations with the federation.

Any association with the federation, must first be approved by a HI marketing team










LOGO LOCKUPS - VERTICAL




